- To ensure sensitivity and commitment to environment and all beings to save the planet for future generation.



INCULCATING LIFESKILLS

Through Meditation Sessions, Morning Assemblies, G.K. & Moral Science Classes

At Bal Bharati Public School, Khandwa, emphasis on values is one of the primary goals. Yoga, Pranayama, Meditation, Stress Management and enhancement of self-awareness sessions are some of the ways in which students are helped to develop their ethical and spiritual side. Lessons in value education and Life Skills have been made a part of the curriculum. The school strives to make education go beyond merely the academic and therefore many classes are run to inculcate life skills. Life Skill classes are conducted in G.K, Moral Science and zero periods aiming at honing skills like Self Awareness, Problem Solving, Decision Making, Critical Thinking, Creative Thinking, Effective Communication, Empathy, Managing Emotions, Dealing with Stress and Interpersonal Relationships.









MEDITATION SESSION IN THE ZERO PERIODS

A meditation session by class teacher in the zero periods is conducted every day for 15 minutes. An interactive conversation among students and the teacher follows up on the topic 'Self Discipline'. School Rules/Classroom Rules are reiterated during this time of the day.

They act as one of the main ways by which we create positive reflective ethos in the school environment and promote our values-based education. Twice a week these assemblies are conducted in the playground and rest of the days in their respective classrooms enable students to develop the deepest values and aspirations of the human spirit. 


MATH & SCIENCE ARE FUN
