Art & Craft Exhibition

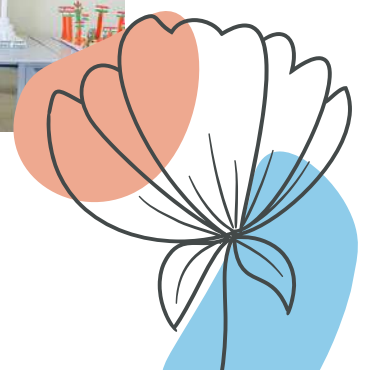
13th - 15th August, 2022

Yellow Day was celebrated with great gusto and energy on Thursday, 25th August 2022 in the school premises by the teachers and students of Nursery - Mont 2.

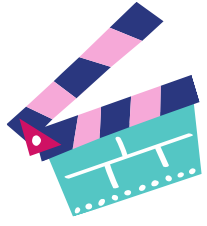

29th AUGUST, 2022



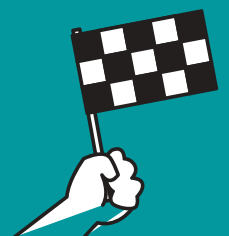

भोपाल। श्रीसिंगाजी प्लांट कारखाना के निदेशक बनेलने में मिथिला बाल भारती पब्लिक स्कूल का संचालन चाइल्ड एजुकेशन सोसाइटी नई दिल्ली ने-मध्य और नो डब्ल्यू के तहत पर कर रहे हैं। निदेशक बनेलने 30 वर्षों का एक अनुबंध भी प्रबंधन और सोसाइटी के बीच में हुआ है। देश भर में चाइल्ड एजुकेशन सोसाइटी द्वारा बाल भारती पब्लिक स्कूल को संचालित करती है।
