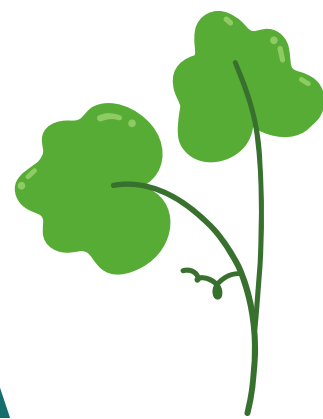

Session I

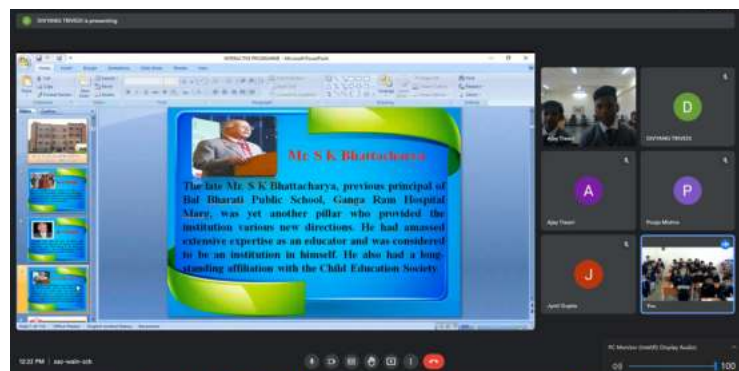
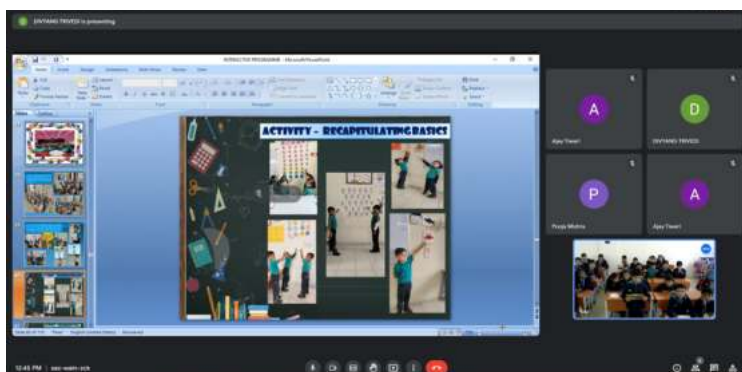
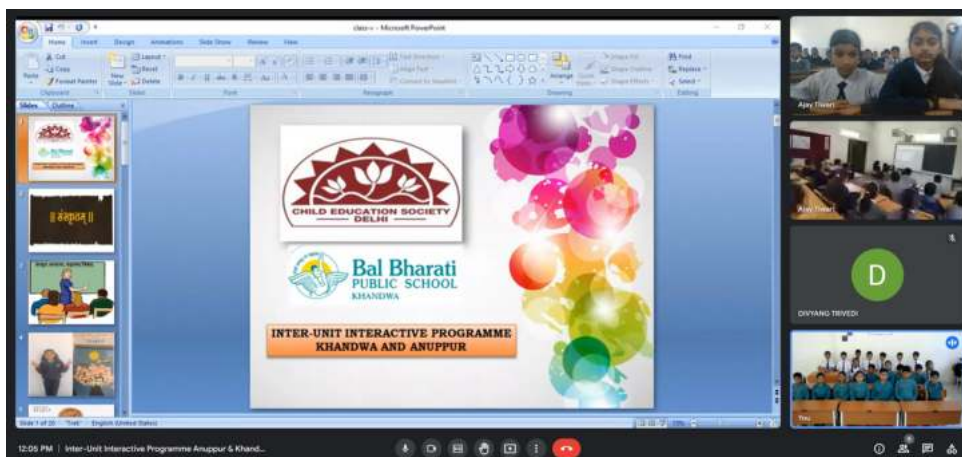

Students contributed very happily within the Inter-Unit Interaction Programme and shared their views.

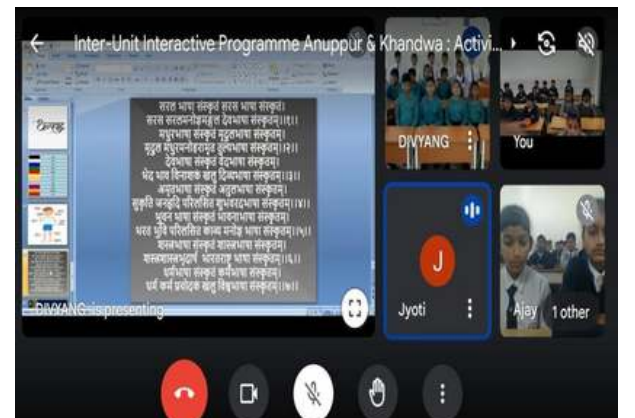


Inter-Unit Interaction Programme with BBPS Annapur

A short power point presentation by the students on the topic Sanskrit language through power point presentation was conducted on 23rd January, 2023

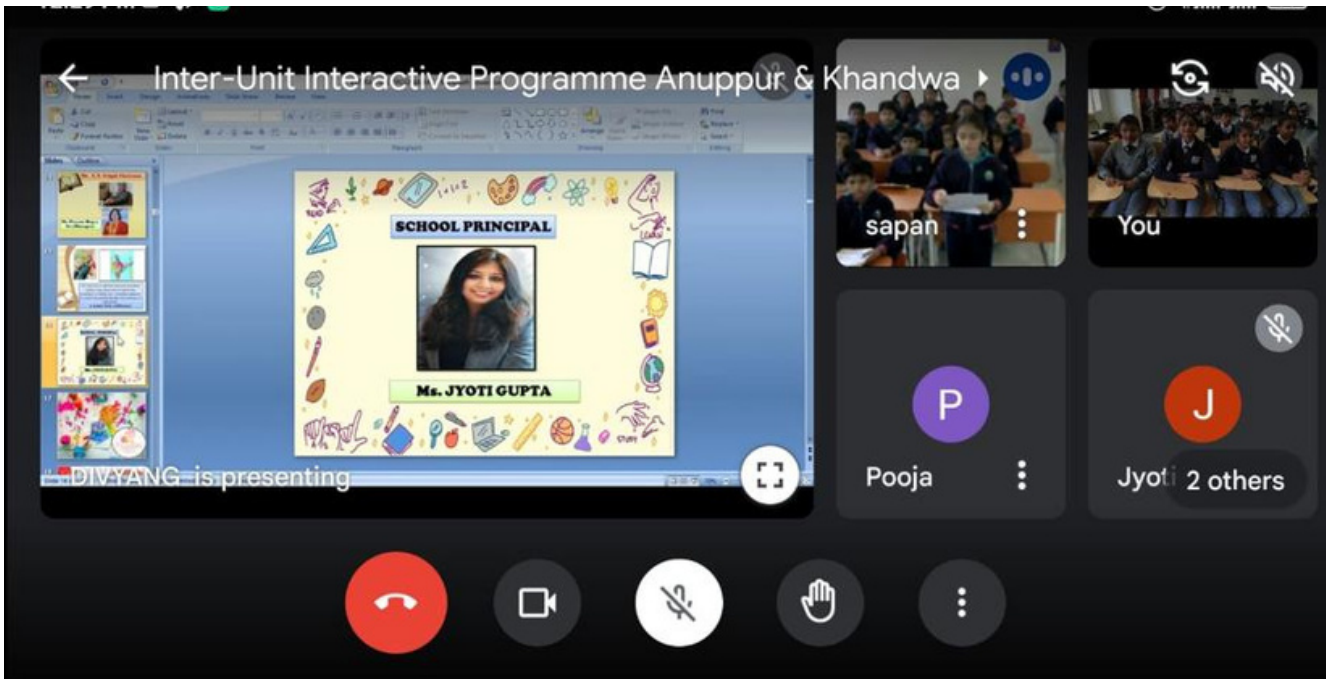
