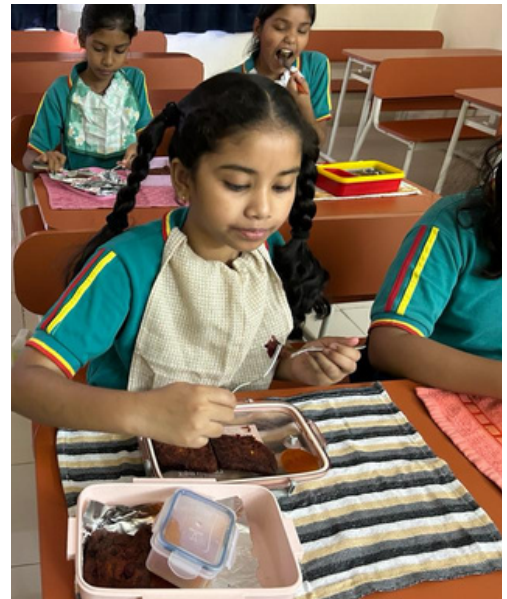


Maths Club - Pointillism (Theme based on Basic Concepts of Geometry i.e. knowledge of points)
