HNDI DIWAS CELEBRATIONS



वर्ष 1918 में गांधी जी ने हिन्दी साहित्य सम्मेलन में हिन्दी भाषा को राजभाषा बनाने को कहा था। इसे गांधी जी ने जनमानस की भाषा भी कहा था। वर्ष 1949 में स्वतंत्र भारत की राजभाषा के प्रश्न पर 14 सितम्बर 1949 को काफी विचार-विमर्श के बाद यह निर्णय लिया गया जो भारतीय संविधान के भाग 17 के अध्याय की अनुच्छेद 343(1) में इस प्रकार वर्णित है: संघ की राजभाषा हिन्दी और लिपि देवनागरी होगी। संघ के राजकीय प्रयोजनों के लिए प्रयोग होने वाले अंकों का रूप अन्तरराष्ट्रीय रूप होगा।

यह निर्णय 14 सितम्बर को लिया गया, इसी दिन हिन्दी के मूर्धन्य साहित्यकार व्यौहार राजेन्द्र सिंह का 50वाँ जन्मदिन था, इस कारण हिन्दी दिवस के लिए इस दिन को श्रेष्ठ माना गया था। हालांकि जब राष्ट्रभाषा के रूप में इसे चुना गया और लागू किया गया तो अ-हिन्दी भाषी राज्य के लोग इसका विरोध करने लगे और अंग्रेजी को भी राजभाषा का दर्जा देना पड़ा।

Inter House Maths Quiz







HAPTCHI ONLINE SESSION

TRAINING & WORKSHOP


