Timings:

Arrival Timings for Classes I to VIII students on 28th and 29th November will be at 2:30 pm. Departure Timings on both days will be at 7:30 pm.

Costumes will be distributed on 28th November, and the full-dress rehearsal will be held on 29th November. Please ensure your child brings a lunch box, water bottle, and school diary for these rehearsal days. Kindly note that students will be dispersed only after the event concludes and will be picked up from their respective class teachers.

Important Information:

• **Preschool and Pre-Primary Non-Operational:** Please note that the school will remain closed for Preschool and Pre-Primary sections on 28th, 29th, and 30th November 2024 in preparation for the Annual Day celebrations. The school will resume from Monday, 2nd December, 2024.


